The instructor brought the class to attention, but the woman across the table from me didn't stop talking. As you know, my hearing is a bit iffy and by the time of our first break, I was beside myself with frustration from the attempt to ignore my much too much chatty classmate and to hear the instructor.

During the break I ran into a friend and I complained bitterly about my circumstance. "Change your seat," she advised. What? That simple? That small?

I had nothing to lose, so I decide to give it a try and just as the class reconvened, I grabbed my stuff and slipped into a seat right up front. My day was retrieved from chaos and I learned two more things.

The first thing was that sometimes just one small change could make a big difference, like changing my seat. However, the biggest lesson I learned was that even I could get caught up in the maelstrom of the moment. I needed to reach out to someone outside of the storm in order to find my way to a solution.

I lesson perhaps, but also a profound truth. How often do we get steeped in the loneliness of our circumstances? It's so tempting to surrender to those feelings of hopelessness and despair. But dearest, that's so against our natures. Aren't we those same people who kept on during those dark days of WWII? Aren't we those same people who endured, who took care of our families when the evidence in front of us seemed to say that all was lost?

It is no different now. The only difference, if you will, is that we are older. But we are wiser, too, filled with all that experience of what works and what doesn't. Yes, I admit that the evidence does look pretty grim sometimes lately, but give our new strategies a try anyway. Contact one of your friends or member of your family; one you can trust and brainstorm on ways that you can make one small change. Just remember that the final decision is yours and yours alone. Let's see what happens. In the meantime, I'm going to explore my list of possibilities.

I have little experience with legal matters, but I do know that the Legal Aid Society of Nassau County may offer your mother some answers for little to no cost. Their phone number is 516-560-6400.

There is also another organization called Minority Affairs that be of help. The number there is 516-571-6174.

As for a Senior Center for Spanish speaking people, try calling the number for Senior Citizen Affairs in Nassau County, (516)227-8900. Some of the centers might have different members who are fluent in Spanish.

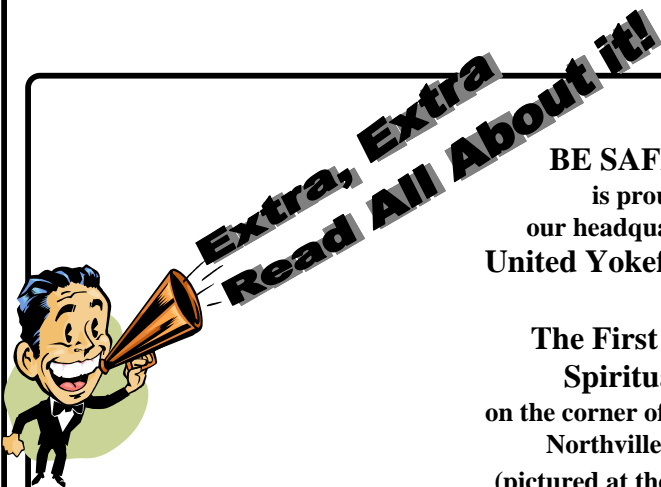
Let me know what happens. And let me say, here, that you are a terrific son!

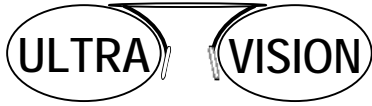
